

# Pipestave Stadium Jumping Practice

## Cross Country Schooling

### Pipestave Derby Cross!

**Sunday August 7, 2011 ~ 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM**

#### **HOW THE DAY WILL RUN – WHAT TO EXPECT**

**7:30 AM** Registration opens. Check in to get your number for stadium/Derby Cross and TICKETS for cross country rounds. If you did not mail a Coggins you will need to present it.

Stadium and Cross Country courses open for walking. (Additional Stadium course walk will be held prior to 2'6" course for 2'6", 2'9", and 3' rounds.)

- Schooling Ring Open. One ring will be set up with a crossrail, vertical and oxer for flat and jumping warm-up. Jumps are FLAGGED to jump in one direction only for safety: Red on the Right, White on the left.
- One cross country jump will be available for warm up (Coop, behind the trailer parking area). It will be FLAGGED to jump in one direction only for safety: Red on the Right, White on the left.

#### **8:00 AM Jumping Rounds begin**

**CROSS COUNTRY:** Ride down to the start and present your ticket to the Starter. He/She will let you know when you can begin by ringing a bell. Riders go one at a time (unless accompanied by an escort.) You can begin your trip when the bell rings.

- If you are also doing Stadium at the lower heights, please do Stadium FIRST. Riders jumping 2'3" or higher should do Cross Country first.
- A 90 second time limit will be imposed for dealing with disobediences during any one jumping round to keep the event moving for all participants.

**STADIUM:** The Stadium Steward will let riders into the ring one at a time. Trainers may coach in the ring.

- Courses will be posted at three levels of difficulty: simple, medium, and difficult. You may jump any pattern at any height, or "take your own line".
- Back to back trips are allowed, (stay in the ring and do two rounds), or come out of the ring while another rider goes between your own trips.
- A 90 second time limit will be imposed for dealing with disobediences during any one jumping round to keep the event moving for all participants.
- There will be a 2-minute "last call" for each height prior to course change. Once fences are raised to the next height, they will not be lowered.
- If you are also doing Cross Country Practice, and doing Stadium 2' or lower, please do your Stadium Practice rounds FIRST, then go to cross country. Riders jumping Stadium at 2'3" or higher should do cross country first
- Additional Stadium course walk will be held prior to 2'6" course for 2'6", 2'9", and 3' rounds.

**10:50 AM** last rounds XC and Stadium (time approximate)

**11:00 AM** Derby Cross course walk for Stadium portion including shortened jump off course

#### **11:15 AM (no earlier): Pipestave Derby Cross Class**

- Divisions/sections based on entries announced (age of rider, horse/pony, etc)
- Order of go will be drawn at random
- Riders sent to Cross Country Starter. At Starter's signal (bell), begin Cross Country portion of Derby Cross round.
- Continue directly into the Stadium ring (no stopping) into Stadium portion of Derby Cross.
- After all riders go, any ties for first place will be broken by timed jump off
- Ride for your ribbons in Derby Cross!
