DETAILS:

- All classes \$30
- Ribbons awarded to places 1-6
- Course walk available from 3-3:15PM
- Pairs who complete a clear course will be signaled to begin their jumpoff round. The jumpoff will be timed and this will determine the placings.
- All judged "A" classes will be ridden before the unjudged "B" classes of that height.
- Coaches allowed in the ring for warm-up and unjudged classes
- NO SMOKING
- Dogs must be on leash and non-disruptive
- All manure, hay, and shavings must be picked up from the parking lot and show grounds. We are lucky to be able to share this facility with many other organizations. Let's not lose that privilege!

ATTIRE:

- Boots, breeches, and safety helmet required (no tank tops please)
- Certified helmets with attached chinstrap are required when mounted
- Riders must wear their assigned number at all times when mounted

CHAMPIONSHIPS:

- A rider is eligible for a Championship Class at a given height if they have participated in at least two Jumper Series shows in the regular judged class at that height.
- Rosettes and prizes are awarded to Championship class winners.
